Residential Site Plan Checklist

A site plan must be completed legibly and to scale, unless expressly stated below.

- 1. Property Owner
- 2. Street Name
- 3. Address or Tax Map Number
- 4. Property Lines with Dimensions (in Feet)
- 5. Setbacks (distance) to all property lines from all Existing and New Construction and/or Structures.
- 6. Location of proposed New Construction and/or Structures
- 7. Overall building dimensions and square footage of New Construction and/or Structures.
- 8. Location and approximate size of Existing Buildings and/or Structures.
- 9. Height of New Construction and/or Structure
- 10. Identify location of Road or Street, and Access Point to it (Driveway).
- 11. Identify known Easements.
- 12. Location, Dimensions, and Area of Driveways and Easements. Label Driveway as New or Existing.
- 13. Location and Dimensions of Septic Tank, Drain Fields, or Sewer, and Distance from New Construction and/or Structure.
- 15 Estimated Land Disturbance (Add Total from #7 #12 if new or expansion & #13)

15. Estimated Land Disturbance (Add Total from #7, #12 if new or expansion, & #13):

** Only numbers 1, 2, & 3 need to be completed for the following: Demolition, Re-Roof, Roof Mounted Solar, Docks/Bulkheads, Change of Use, Renovation, Replace or Remove Fuel Tanks (Specify Location of Existing Tank), or Elevation of House. **

** Docks/Bulkheads – Include Site Plan from JPA Application **

14. Area of New Construction and/or Structures (From #7):

- ** Only numbers 1-8 & 13-15 need to be completed if you are applying for a Pool **
- ** Only numbers 1 9 & 13 15 need to be completed if you are applying for an Addition **
