## Management Report for Star Transit March 2013

### **Operations**

• *Performance Evaluations* – Evaluations have been completed for the drivers. Each driver was evaluated on their pre-trip inspections, appearance, customer service and their driving skills. All the drivers' evaluations were satisfactory.

### **Transit Capital**

• **Bus Stop Shelter Program** - Star Transit staff have contacted the Walmart management team about installing a bus stop shelter at the Walmart store in Onley. Walmart is considering this request and hopefully will make a decision soon. VRT has a number of bus stop shelters currently on Walmart property.

#### **Human Resources**

• *Driver Training* - STAR Transit is planning to do a ½ day driver training. The topic and the date have yet to be determined.

### **Marketing and Outreach**

• *Transit Advertising on STAR Transit Buses* - VRT management staff contacted Tim Brazil with Media Transit the company that handles the bus advertising for Star Transit. Mr. Brazil indicated that unfortunately the Community College had reduced their advertising to just one bus because of state budget cuts; however Mr. Brazil indicated that

he was working on developing new business partners on the Eastern Shore and is planning a multi-day sales trip during the month of March to meet with prospective advertising partners.

### **Transit Maintenance**

• *Preventive Maintenance Program* - All STAR Transit vehicles have been serviced for the month of February and all vehicle records are up to date.

#### **Ridership Statistics for January 2013**

• *Ridership Statistics* -STAR Transit carried approximately 6790 passengers in February as compared to 5762 passengers this time last year. This is a 17.8% increase in ridership.

#### In Re: Railroad Comments

Mr. LeMond shared the following report with the Commission:

1. <u>Traffic</u>: With one month to go in our fiscal year, I am happy to report that we have experienced a 400 carload increase YOY.

2. <u>VPA Fund Request</u>: If you recall, we did not make a funding request to the VPA last year. But, now that we have new customers using the float operation, we need to do some work to the float bridges and pontoons. We are requesting \$144,750 to partially fund these repairs. The Bay Coast RR will provide the 25% match = \$48,250.

Asking for approval from the ANTDC for this request.

Motion was made by Mr. Hart, seconded by Mr. Randall, that the grant request to the Virginia Port Authority be approved as submitted. All members were present and voted "yes." The motion was unanimously passed.
