PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES

As a member of a team (2-3 firefighters), safely and quickly deploy an attack line and gain access into the building. Maintaining team integrity, attack techniques facilitate suppression given the level of the fire, hazards are avoided and/or managed, and the fire is brought under control.

The team will conduct a primary search and remove any victims located without compromising team safety or integrity. Communication with command is essential.

TACTICAL OBJECTIVE

Crew will pull and advance attack line into the structure and perform a primary search of the second and first floors.

GUIDELINES

- Wear full personal protective equipment and SCBA
- Pull appropriate back-up attack line as ordered and advance to entry point
- Line shall be charged, flowed to remove air, nozzle set on a narrow fog pattern or straight stream
- Access into the building shall be made, controlling the entry point door
- Entry will be made on side B second story
- Crew shall advance line into structure
- Crew shall perform a primary search on the second floor and first floor
- Crew shall extinguish fires as encountered and ensure safety of the crew on floors 2 & 1
- Right hand or left hand search patterns are used
- Located victims shall be communicated to command
- Point of exit shall be communicated to command
- Victim shall be removed from structure and communicated to command
- Crew will maintain full accountability of all members during the evolution
- Crew shall return to structure and complete primary search/fire suppression
- Crew shall notify command when task has been completed and wait for orders
