## **PURPOSE**

To outline the responsibilities of the employee when an infraction of a law has been committed.

## **SCOPE**

All department employees.

## **DEFINITION**

Legal infractions are defined as any employee encounters with law enforcement. This is to include the following but are not limited to:

- Traffic violation
- Domestic violations
- Felony or misdemeanor arrest
- Any other encounter with law enforcement

## **CONTENT**

Employees will notify their supervisor or the Director of any legal infraction (whether job related or not), as soon as possible, and no later than 24 hours after the date of the incident.

If notified, the supervisor will insure timely notification to the Director through the employee's chain of command.
