1). A request from Robert L. Parks, Jr. for a Variance from Article IV, Section 106-83(a) Side Yard Regulations for a garage addition at 7399 Justice Farm Lane,
County Tax Map# 28A-6-24, Wallops Island, Virginia.

Mr. Robert L. Parks, Jr. appeared before the Board to represent this application and presented the certified mail receipts of the adjoining property owners. Mr. Parks asked for a variance for a garage addition to be 10 feet from the side property line instead of the required 15 feet. He explained that the proposed location was the only feasible area for the garage as the septic and drainfields were located on the other side of the cottage and the land to the rear was considerably sloped.

A discussion ensued about detaching the proposed garage thereby eliminating the need for the variance entirely. Mr. Parks indicated that a detached garage would not provide enough space for access to the back of the property and discussed future plans to build a larger house to the front of the lot and converting the existing building to an accessory building.

No one appeared nor signed in opposition to this request.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Drewer made a motion to approve this variance with the condition that once the future home is built on the property, the existing structure must be used as an accessory/utility building. Mr. Kerns seconded the motion. Ayes: Mr. Nock, Mrs. Kerns, and Mr. Drewer.
