# ACCOMACK COUNTY, VIRGINIA, ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 34, ELECTIONS, ARTICLE II, ELECTION DISTRICTS, SEC. 34-32, DISTRICT POPULATIONS, AND SEC. 34-33, DISTRICT BOUNDARIES, AND ARTICLE III, PRECINCTS, SEC. 34-67, POLLING PLACES AND SEC. 34-68, MAP ADOPTED

**WHEREAS**, The Accomack County Board of Supervisors, is desirous of amending the County Code to update the population information, district boundaries, polling places and map adopted in Accomack County pursuant to the 2010 Census; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IN ENACTED that the Board of Supervisors of Accomack County, Virginia, amend Accomack County Code, Chapter 34, Elections, Article II, Election Districts, Sec. 34-32, District Populations, and Sec. 34-33, District Boundaries, and Article III, Precincts, Sec. 34-67, Polling Places, and Sec. 34-68, Map Adopted, as follows:

Section 34-32 as previously shown in the Accomack County Code is hereby deleted in its entirety. The Districts shall be as set forth below:

Election District 1 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: On the north, by the Maryland—Virginia line; on the east, by the Atlantic Ocean; on the southwest and northwest by a line beginning at a point in the center of Chincoteague Inlet, and running generally in a northeasterly direction to the center of Chincoteague Channel; thence turning in a northwesterly direction along the center of Chincoteague Channel to the center of Queen Sound Channel; thence northwesterly along the center of Queen Sound Channel to Chincoteague Bay; thence turning in a northeasterly direction to the Maryland—Virginia State dividing line along the existing Atlantic/The Island Magisterial District line as shown on the hereafter referenced map.\*

Election District 2 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at the point which is the intersection of the Accomack County, Virginia and the existing Atlantic/The Island Magisterial district line on the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line, thence westerly along the State dividing line where it is crossed by a power transmission line approximately 475 feet east of where Silverthorne Rd. (Rt. 714) crosses the state line; thence southwesterly along said power line to where it crosses Sign Post Rd. (Rt.712); thence easterly along Sign Post Rd. to Fleming Rd. (Rt. 679), thence southerly along Fleming Rd. to Justice Rd. (Rt. 709); thence southeasterly along Justice Rd. to an unnamed road approximately 500 feet from the intersection of Fleming Rd. and Justice Rd. (Rt. 709); thence southwesterly along unnamed road approximately 890 feet to it's terminus at a second unnamed road; thence northwesterly along unnamed road to Fleming Rd. thence southwesterly along Fleming Rd. until it is crossed with a power transmission line; thence southwesterly along power line until it again crosses Fleming Rd.; thence southerly along Fleming Rd. to Chincoteague Rd. (Rt. 175) thence easterly along Chincoteague Rd. to where it bisects

Wallops Mill Pond; thence southwesterly bisecting Wallops Mill Pond to the remaining portion of Wattsville Branch; thence southerly to where the remaining portion of Wattsville Branch is crossed by Fleming Rd. (Rt. 679); thence southeasterly along Fleming Rd. until it intersects Atlantic Rd. (Rt. 679 and Rt. 798) and Wright Rd. (Rt. 766); thence southerly along Atlantic Rd. (Rt. 679) intersects Nocks Landing Rd (Rt. 702); thence northwesterly along Nocks Landing Rd. until it intersects Southwind Rd (Rt. 845); thence southwesterly along Southwind Rd until it terminates at Greta Rd (Rt. 703); thence southeasterly along Greta Rd. until it terminates at Atlantic Rd.; thence southerly along Atlantic Rd until Wisharts Point Rd (Rt. 695); thence southeasterly along Wisharts Point Rd. for approximately 3,500 feet to an unnamed road between Wisharts Point Rd. and Taylor Farm Rd. (Rt. 781); thence southerly along unnamed road to Taylor Farm Rd.; thence northwesterly along Taylor Farm Rd. to Atlantic Rd.; thence southerly along Atlantic Rd. approximately 660 feet to an unnamed road; thence northwesterly along unnamed road until it terminates at Temperanceville Rd. (Rt. 695); thence westerly and northwesterly along Temperanceville Rd., New Temperanceville Rd., New Saxis Rd., and Saxis Rd. (all Rt. 695) to where it crosses Sandy Bottom Branch; thence southwesterly along Sandy Bottom Branch until it is crossed by Neal Parker Rd. (Rt. 693), thence southwesterly along Neal Parker Rd. until it intersects with an unnamed private road forming the northern boundary of Census Tract 0903, Block 2028, approximately 4,000 feet north of the Hallwood corporate limits; thence westerly approximately 410 feet until unnamed road is crossed by a power transmission line; then southwesterly along such power transmission line to the Town of Hallwood Corporate Limits; thence northwesterly, southwesterly and southeasterly along the Town of Hallwood Corporate Limits to the power transmission line aforesaid south of the Town of Hallwood Corporate Limits; thence southwesterly along power transmission line approximately 850 feet until transmission line crosses a branch of Messongo Creek; thence easterly along the center of Messongo Creek until it is crossed by Bethel Church Rd. (Rt. 687); thence southerly along Bethel Church Rd. until it intersects with Groton Town Rd. (Rt. 691); thence southeasterly along Groton Town Rd. until it intersects with Charles M. Lankford Memorial Highway (U.S. Rt. 13); thence northerly along the center of Charles M. Lankford Memorial Highway to John Taylor Rd. (Rt. 691); thence easterly along John Taylor Rd. to Metompkin Rd. (Rt. 697), thence southerly along Metompkin Rd. to Hog Neck Rd. (Rt. 604) to unnamed branch which runs into Northam Narrows; thence southerly in the middle of Northam Narrows until it reaches Kegotank Bay; thence southerly in the middle of the channel through Kegotank Bay and Kegotank Creek to Gargathy Inlet; from Gargathy Inlet due east to the Accomack County Line off the Eastern Shore in the Atlantic Ocean; thence northeasterly along the Accomack County Line in the Atlantic Ocean to the existing Atlantic/The Island Magisterial District line south of Chincoteague Inlet; thence northerly through the center of Chincoteague Inlet to Chincoteague Channel; thence northeasterly through the center of Chincoteague Channel to the center of Queen Sound Channel; thence northwesterly along the center of Queen Sound Channel to Chincoteague Bay; thence turning in a northeasterly direction to the Maryland—Virginia State dividing line along the existing Atlantic/The Island Magisterial District line at the point of origin.

Election District 3 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at a point on the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line which intersects with a power transmission line approximately 475 feet east of where Silverthorne Rd. (Rt. 714) crosses the state line; thence southwesterly along said power line to where it crosses Sign Post Rd. (Rt.712); thence easterly along Sign Post Rd. to Fleming Rd. (Rt. 679), thence southerly along Fleming Rd. to Justice Rd. (Rt. 709); thence southeasterly along Justice Rd. to an unnamed road approximately 500 feet from the intersection of Fleming Rd. and Justice Rd. (Rt. 709); thence southwesterly along unnamed road approximately 890 feet to its terminus at a second unnamed road; thence northwesterly along unnamed road to Fleming Rd. thence southwesterly along Fleming Rd. until it is crossed with a power transmission line; thence southwesterly along power line until it again crosses Fleming Rd.; thence southerly along Fleming Rd. to Chincoteague Rd. (Rt. 175) thence easterly along Chincoteague Rd. to where it bisects Wallops Mill Pond; thence southwesterly bisecting Wallops Mill Pond to the remaining portion of Wattsville Branch; thence southerly to where the remaining portion of Wattsville Branch is crossed by Fleming Rd. (Rt. 679); thence southeasterly along Fleming Road until it intersects Atlantic Rd. (Rt. 679 and Rt. 798) and Wright Rd. (Rt. 766); thence southerly along Atlantic Rd. (Rt. 679) to Nocks Landing Rd (Rt. 702); thence northwesterly along Nocks Landing Rd. until it intersects Southwind Rd (Rt. 845); thence southwesterly along Southwind Rd until it terminates at Greta Rd (Rt. 703); thence southeasterly along Greta Rd. until it terminates at Atlantic Rd.; thence southerly along Atlantic Rd until Wisharts Point Rd (Rt. 695); thence southeasterly along Wisharts Point Rd. for approximately 3,500 feet to an unnamed road between Wisharts Point Rd. and Taylor Farm Rd. (Rt. 781); thence southerly along unnamed road to Taylor Farm Rd.; thence northwesterly along Taylor Farm Rd. to Atlantic Rd.; thence southerly along Atlantic Rd. approximately 660 feet to an unnamed road; thence northwesterly along unnamed road until it terminates at Temperanceville Rd. (Rt. 695); thence westerly and northwesterly along Temperanceville Rd., New Temperanceville Rd., New Saxis Rd., and Saxis Rd. (all Rt. 695) to where it crosses Sandy Bottom Branch; thence southwesterly along Sandy Bottom Branch until it is crossed by Neal Parker Rd. (Rt. 693), thence southwesterly along Neal Parker Rd. until it intersects with an unnamed private road forming the northern boundary of Census Tract 0903, Block 2028, approximately 4,000 feet north of the Hallwood corporate limits; thence generally westsouthwesterly along unnamed private road until its terminus at Savannah Rd. (Rt. 692) north of Messongo Creek; thence northwesterly along Savannah Rd to its intersection with Ross Rd. (Rt. 737); thence northeasterly along Ross Road until it intersects with Messongo Rd. (Rt. 700); thence northwesterly along Messongo Rd. to its intersection with Marsh Market Rd. (Rt. 698); thence northerly along Marsh Market Rd. to its intersection with Saxis Rd. (Rt. 695), thence westerly along Saxis Rd. to an unnamed private road approximately 750 feet northwesterly of the westernmost intersection of Saxis Rd. and Broadwater Dr. (Rt. 826); thence northerly along unnamed private road to terminus of road at Pocomoke Sound; thence north through Pocomoke Sound to the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line; thence northerly and easterly along the state dividing line to the point of origin.

Election District 4 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at a point on the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line in Pocomoke Sound which is the extension of an unnamed private road running from Saxis Rd. (Rt. 695) north to Pocomoke Sound, said road intersection falls between intersection of Saxis Rd. (Rt. 695) and Tall Pines Lane, approximately 750 feet northwest of the westernmost intersection of Saxis Rd. (Rt. 695) and Broadwater Dr. (Rt. 826); thence southerly along said line through Pocomoke Sound to terminus of unnamed road; thence southerly along unnamed road to its intersection with Saxis Rd. (Rt. 695); thence easterly along Saxis Rd. to its intersection with Marsh Market Rd. (Rt. 698); then southerly along Marsh Market Rd. to its intersection with Messongo Rd. (Rt. 692), thence southeasterly along Savannah Rd. to its intersection with an unnamed private road approximately 800 feet north of where Savannah Rd. crosses Messongo Creek; thence northeasterly along unnamed private road to a transmission line crossing of unnamed road about 410 feet west of terminus of unnamed road with Neal Parker Rd. until it intersects the Bay Coast Railroad; thence southwesterly along said rail line until its crossing of Lee Mont Branch; thence westerly along the center of Lee Mont Branch to Hunting Creek; thence northerly along the center of Hunting Creek to The Thorofare; thence northwesterly through The Thorofare, Guilford Flats, Beasley Bay and Pocomoke Sound to a point on the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line west of where Fishing Creek empties into Pocomoke Sound; thence easterly along the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line to the point of origin.

Election District 5 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at a point in on the Accomack County Line in the Atlantic Ocean which is due east of Metompkin Inlet; thence east through Metompkin Inlet to Metompkin Bay; Northwesterly through Metompkin Bay to Parker Creek; thence westerly to North Fork of Parker Creek; thence northerly to terminus of Fox Grove Rd (Rt. 666); thence northerly to Alicato Rd. (Rt. 786); thence easterly approximately 1800 feet to unnamed road which forms the southeastern boundary of Census Tract 0904, Block 3035; thence northwesterly to Fox Grove Rd; thence southerly to Johnson Rd Rt. 661; thence southwesterly to North Fork of Parker Creek; thence northerly to Lankford Hwy; thence southwesterly to Mary N. (Rt. 678); thence northeasterly to Dennis Dr. (Rt. 676); thence northwesterly to Chandler Rd. (Rt. 653); thence northeasterly to Berry Rd. (Rt. 680); thence northerly to Mason Rd. (Rt. 681); thence northwesterly to Power transmission line; thence northerly to Nelsonia Rd. (Rt. 187); thence easterly to Fletcher Rd. (Rt. 688); thence northerly to power transmission line which crosses Fletcher Rd.; thence northerly to Bethel Church Rd. (Rt. 687); thence northeasterly to Groton Town Rd. (Rt. 691); thence southeasterly along Groton Town Rd. until it intersects with Charles M. Lankford Memorial Highway (U.S. Rt. 13); thence northerly along the center of Charles M. Lankford Memorial Highway to John Taylor Rd. (Rt. 691); thence easterly along John Taylor Rd. to Metompkin Rd. (Rt. 697), thence southerly along Metompkin Rd. to Hog Neck Rd. (Rt. 604) to unnamed branch which runs into Northam Narrows; thence southerly in the middle of Northam Narrows until it reaches Kegotank Bay; thence southerly in the middle of the channel through Kegotank Bay and Kegotank Creek to Gargathy Inlet; from Gargathy Inlet due east to the Accomack County Line off the Eastern Shore in the Atlantic Ocean; thence southerly in the Atlantic Ocean along the Accomack County line to the point of origin.

Election District 6 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at a point on the Virginia/Maryland State dividing line west of where Fishing Creek empties into Pocomoke Sound; thence westerly along line until reaching the Accomack County/Northumberland County Line in the Chesapeake Bay; thence southerly along line until reaching a point due west of the light near the mouth of Back Creek; thence easterly to the mouth of Back Creek; thence generally easterly along the center of Back Creek and associated drainage ditch until said ditch is crossed by India Ln. (private), thence southeasterly along India Ln. until it terminates at Poplar Cove Rd. (Rt. 653); thence generally easterly along Poplar Cove Rd. until it intersects North St./Town Rd. (Rt. 658); thence generally southerly along North St. until it crosses the north branch of Onancock Creek, said branch being the Onancock Corporate Line; thence southeasterly along said branch/corporate line until it is crossed by Fairgrounds Rd. (Rt. 126), thence easterly along Fairgrounds Rd. until it intersects Taylor Rd. (Rt. 650); thence southeasterly along Taylor Rd. until the intersection of Charles M. Lankford Memorial Highway (U.S. Rt. 13); thence northeasterly to Daugherty Rd. (Rt. 648); thence southeasterly to Drummondtown Rd. (Rt. 605); thence northerly to unnamed ditch and branch feeding into Ross Branch approximately 800 feet north of intersection of Daugherty and Drummondtown Rd.; thence easterly along unnamed branch to Ross Brach; thence easterly to Folly Creek and easterly down the center of Folly Creek to Metompkin Bay; thence northwesterly through Metompkin Bay to Parker Creek; thence westerly to the North Fork of Parker Creek; thence northerly to the terminus of Fox Grove Rd (Rt. 666); thence northerly to Alicato Rd. (Rt. 786); thence easterly approximately 1800 feet to unnamed road which forms the southeastern boundary of Census Tract 0904, Block 3035; thence northwesterly to Fox Grove Rd.; thence southerly to Johnson Rd (Rt. 661); thence southwesterly to North Fork of Parker Creek; thence northerly to Lankford Hwy.; thence southwesterly to Mary N. (private); thence southeasterly along India Ln. until it terminates at Poplar Cove Rd. (Rt. 653); thence generally easterly along Poplar Cove Rd. until it intersects North St./Town Rd. Election District 8 shall consist of the area in Accomack County, bounded and described as follows: Starting at a point in the Atlantic Ocean on the Accomack County line which is due east of Wachapreague Inlet; thence west to Wachapreague Inlet; thence westerly to Black Rock Reach; thence northerly to Wachapreague Channel; thence northwesterly to Burtons Bay; thence northwesterly to Upper Haul Over; thence westerly to Finney Creek; thence up the middle of Finney Creek northerly to Drummondtown Rd. (Route 605); thence westerly to Locustville Rd. (Rt. 789); thence northwesterly to Town of Onley Corporate Limits; thence westerly around the southern boundary of Onley to Badger Lane (Rt. 638); thence northwesterly to Cashville Rd. (Rt. 638); thence westerly to Mount Nebo Rd. (Rt. 637); thence southwesterly to Dingleys Mill Rd. (Rt. 626); thence southerly to the middle of Pungoteague Creek; thence westerly to the middle of Pungoteague Creek to the Chesapeake Bay; thence west to Accomack/Northumberland County Line; thence south to the intersection of the Accomack/Northumberland and Accomack/Lancaster County Line; thence east to the mouth of Nandua Creek; thence northeast up Nandua creek to a point where the end of Nandua Rd (Rt. 617) extends to the center of Nandua Creek; thence southeasterly to terminus of Nandua Rd. (Rt. 617); thence southeasterly to Boston Rd. (Rt. 617) extends to the center of Nandua Creek; thence southeasterly to terminus of Nandua Rd. (Rt. 617); thence southeasterly to Boston Rd. (Rt. 182); thence southeasterly along Mappsburg Rd. and Quinby Bridge Rd. (Rt. 182) to Machipongo River; thence southwesterly following the southern channel through Moreland Swamp crossing Cat's Bridge Rd. (Rt. 603) to Parting Creek; thence southerly to Accomack/Northampton Line at Parting Creek; thence northwesterly along Accomack/Northampton Line to same line in Occohannock Creek; thence westerly along Accomack/Northampton Line in Occohannock Creek and Chesapeake Bay to intersection with Middlesex County line; thence northerly in Chesapeake Bay along Accomack/Middlesex County line to intersection with Accomack/Lancaster County line; thence northerly along Accomack/Lancaster Line to point of origin.
