5. INFORMATIONAL REPORT FROM CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS

A. Ms. Rhode

Ms. Rhode gave an update on a 2/5/18 meeting that she and Chair Edwards had with County Attorney Cela Burge concerning the Marshall Property default. The outcome of the meeting was a demand letter referencing the Promissory Note between MTSF, Inc. and the EDA of Accomack County. The letter was dated 2/6/18 and sent from the EDA to MTSF, Inc. Ms. Rhode asked for discussion concerning the EDA's intent going forward in order to provide guidance to Ms. Burge. General consensus after much discussion was to authorize Ms. Rhode and Mr. Edwards to proceed to try to collect the delinquency and use all means available to do so. Mr. Calvert Seybolt made the motion for the "EDA Board to authorize Mr. Edwards and Ms. Rohde to proceed as necessary to collect delinquent funds, to undertake actions necessary pertaining to the Marshall property to get the note current or to collect the entire amount due per contract." Mr. C. Ray Davis seconded the motion and all voted in favor of the motion.

B. Mr. Edwards

Mr. Edwards presented the concept of having the timber cut on approximately 15 acres on Parkway Boulevard. On 2/9/18, Mr. Watt Tyler contacted Mr. Edwards. After much discussion, the general consensus was to direct Mr. Edwards to call Mr. Tyler and state that the EDA is not interested in having the timber cut at this time.
